ICS Paris

ICS Paris is a well-known school in the XVth district of Paris, educating students from 70 different countries across an age range of three to 18 years old. The school welcomes students in an inspiring, warm and inclusive environment and is a leading International Baccalaureate School Group in Europe. ICS Paris fosters all the values at the heart of an IB education from primary to high school and its 500-strong student community has a small-class policy and a tailored English-speaking curriculum that is enhanced by French lessons from the age of three. The school has a strong STEAM curriculum and recently installed a well-resourced "Fab Lab" for STEAM activities. Graduates attend some of the most prestigious universities in the world and achieve high scores in their IBDP.

The school is located close to Montparnasse Station and to Parc George Brassens, and takes the approach that Paris is the school's classroom. The school has a unique partnership with the city's largest sports waterpark and leisure centre, offering 30+ sports, swimming lessons and waterpark access - students visit once a week and have access to expert coaches. Primary students also spend time in the neighbouring park every day.

RIS Rome

RIS Rome offers an international English-centred education for students aged two to 18, with more than 45 nationalities represented in the student community. The school offers the IB PYP and Diploma, and Cambridge IGCSE as well as the Italian Ministerial Programme.

Founded in 1988, the school is proud of its status as one of the first Eco-Schools in Globeducate, on a modern campus set in a forest – a very green location for a city school with over three hectares of natural wonders, offering extensive opportunities for students of all ages to take their learning outdoors and beyond the classroom. RIS Rome students have excellent preparation for higher education study and graduates from the school attend high ranking universities of their choice, worldwide. These students also leave with an established set of personal values that will lay the foundation for international mindedness and critical thinking, essential for the future. The school's location is just north of the city centre, not far from the Foro Italico sports complex and the Olympic Village.

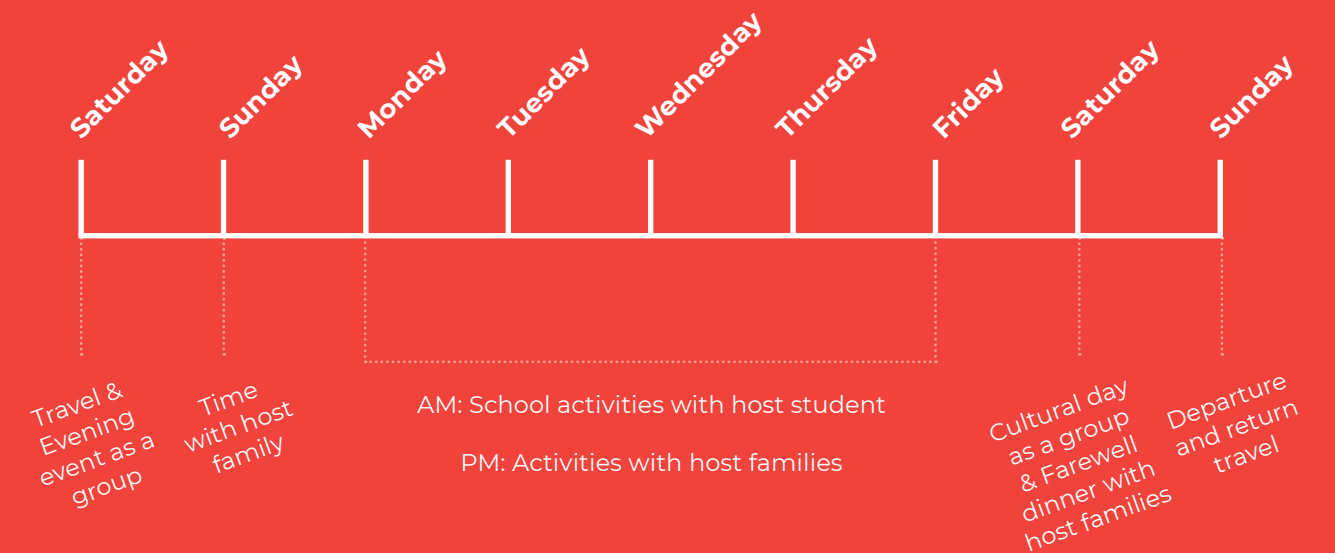

Attending another ICS school in the group gives these students a window into what fellow IB students are working on, how they learn, what they have in common and how they can learn from each other. It builds a sense of community and shared experience of the IB Learner Profile along with giving opportunities for future travel, exchanges of ideas about CAS activities and other personal challenges these young people may inspire each other to take on. It promotes peer-learning and peer-mentorship that may develop spontaneously and over time.
